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1. The first possible solution is to avoid the use of a short column in the architectural design stage itself. 2. If short columns cannot be ignored, special design requirements are followed. As per ACI code, for those columns that have chances to undergo short column effect will require special confining reinforcement called the ductile reinforcement.

A short column differs from a medium or long column, each of which can fail by bending when evenly loaded along the axis. No single specific length or range of lengths defines a short column. Rather, whether a column is considered to be short depends on a variety of factors. A short column may be made of various materials including structural steel, aluminum alloys, reinforced concrete, or even wood. ### 4.1.1 Choosing a Chart Type: Line Charts – Excel For ...

A column is considered to be long if the ratio of effective length of column to its least lateral dimension is greater than 12. The ratio of effective length of a short column to its least radius of gyration is less than or equal to 40. The ratio of effective length of a long column to its least radius of gyration is greater than 40.

### CHAPTER 4. Reinforced Concrete - assakkaf

The majority of reinforced concrete columns are subjected to primary stresses caused by flexure, axial force, and shear. Secondary stresses associated with deformations are usually very small in most columns used in practice. These columns are referred to as "short columns."

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
