Lupus information booklet - Versus Arthritis

This trial will test whether Belimumab can be used to prevent flares in patients with SLE post Rituximab therapy. The research teams at 16 participating NHS Hospitals within the UK will test the effectiveness of treating patients with both Belimumab, (Benlysta) an antibody that blocks the actions of the B cell growth factor BAFF, and Rituximab, a drug designed specifically to deplete B cells.

Lupus affected nearly 1 in 1,000 of the population in 2012 in the UK. The age-standardised incidence in the UK is 8.3/100,000/year for females and 1.4/100,000/year for males in the UK. The highest incidence rates are seen in those of African-Caribbean descent, 31.4/100,000/year compared to 6.7/100,000/year for those of white European

This means the body's natural defence system (immune system) attacks healthy parts of your body. It's not contagious. The causes of lupus are not fully understood. Possible causes include: viral infection; certain medicines; sunlight

Systemic lupus erythematosus (SLE) can be difficult to diagnose, as it has similar symptoms to several other, far more common, conditions. Diagnosis may also be difficult because symptoms can vary greatly from person to person, and they may change over time.

Hydroxychloriquine commonly is prescribed for people with lupus. It can cause vision changes in some people, so regular exams are important. BLYS-specific inhibitors. Belimumab was approved in 2011 specifically for the treatment of lupus. It suppresses autoantibodies in people with lupus. Acthar is an FDA-approved hormone treatment used for lupus.

Lupus in Dogs. Systemic lupus erythematosus (SLE) is a chronic, multisystem autoimmune disease characterized by episodes of disease flare and remission. Recent studies have found a disease prevalence of 0.073% in the US 1, 2 and 0.097% in the UK 3, with a suggestion that the prevalence of SLE is increasing 3.
