Reversible Reactions | Teaching Resources

When you think of chemical reactions, you might think of them as irreversible, permanently changing one substance into another. While this is true in some cases, some chemical reactions are reversible, and we can take the products of the reaction and turn them back into the reactants. These reversible reactions can, under certain conditions, reach what we call ‘equilibrium’.

Reversible Reactions, Equilibrium, and Le Châtelier's ...

Reversible reaction: dehydration of blue copper sulfate. Blue copper sulfate is hydrated which means that the copper and sulfate ions in its crystal structure are surrounded by water molecules. When heated, the water is driven off, producing anhydrous copper sulfate which is a white solid. The reaction is reversible, which means that as soon as any water is around, anhydrous copper sulfate will be converted back into the blue hydrated form.
