Crematorium I Crematorium I operated [at Auschwitz] from August 15, 1940 until July 1943. According to calculations by the German authorities, 340 corpses could be burned every 24 hours after the installation of the three furnaces. The largest room in this building was designated as a morgue.

In the book Commandant of Auschwitz[19] cremation capacities for Auschwitz II are discussed which can be used to calculate incineration times (page 181). The two smaller crematoria (Nos. IV and V) had -- according to the book -- 16 cremators and could dispose of 3000 corpses daily.

The Problem of Cremator Hours and Incineration Time

It takes hours to burn one body in a civilian crematorium. How could the ovens at Auschwitz-Birkenau cremate nearly 900,000 victims in a two-year period? At Auschwitz-Birkenau, the ovens operated continuously, burning multiple bodies at once. We cannot compare that to the cremation process in civilian crematoria.
